# SIT, STAY, READ!

BPL is excited to partner with Becky Liehr and her registered therapy dog, Hodge, in order to provide children the opportunity to read to a dog. Similar programs are offered in libraries and schools all over the country as a way to engage kids who are just learning to read or are otherwise struggling readers. Reading to trained and certified animals has proven to be effective in helping children overcome shyness, build confidence and improve reading skills. Hodge is non-judgmental, calm, attentive, less intimidating



than peers and adults, does not laugh or criticize, enjoys children and loves being petted! Becky and Hodge will be at BPL on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Thursdays of each month for four 15-minute sessions. Check BPL's website and social media on the first of the month to see the link to sign up for a reading session. Parents and caregivers are encouraged to remain outside of the reading room, which will help ensure that the young readers are relaxed and feeling minimal pressure and anxiety. The child, Hodge and Becky can easily be viewed through a window and the door can remain open. "We're very excited to offer this opportunity and I'm grateful to Becky Liehr for reaching out to us with the idea," says Laura Pryce, Youth Services Librarian.

# White Rose Cemetery Luminary Service

The annual White Rose Luminary Service will take place at 6:00 PM on Saturday, November 19th at the White Rose Mausoleum. The purpose of the Luminary Service is to honor and remember those we have lost.

Luminaries, which consist of a small paper sack weighted with sand and



illuminated from within by an LED light, are placed around the halls of the Mausoleum. Each luminary has a card attached with the loved ones name and by whom they are being honored. After a service including a speaker, music, and reading of the names of those being remembered, guests are invited to take their luminary and place it on the grave of their loved one. Loved ones do not have to be buried at White Rose Cemetery to have a luminary created in their memory.

Luminaries may be purchased for \$5.00 each.




