#### White Rose Mausoleum Centennial Celebration

White Rose Cemetery will be hosting a Centennial Celebration for the Mausoleum on July 8th at 10:00 am. All of the speakers for our program are related to someone entombed in the Mausoleum. Refreshments will be provided. In 1921, the Bartlesville city commissioners and C.E. Bryan agreed to begin construction of a mausoleum at White Rose Cemetery. Hugh Bryant, also known as Sonny Jim Bryant, was a Bartlesville pioneer businessman who founded the mausoleum at White Rose Cemetery.



The 15,000-square-foot mausoleum is in the Greek Neoclassic architectural style and it houses over 500 crypts. The exterior is made of concrete and stone with bronze doors. The roof is made of vitrified tile, which is a mix of clay and silica. The interior is made of white marble. The windows are also made of bronze and include ornamental stained glass. We encourage everyone to come to our celebration. The mausoleum will be open and available to view after our program. We honor those who rest there and appreciate the history behind this unique Bartlesville landmark.






Collection Get out and get active!


### **Fall Gardens**

### **GOT A SUGGESTION?**

The library adds books, DVDs, audiobooks, outdoor games, and other items all year long. Users can suggest a book or item purchase by asking for a form at the circulation or reference desk or through the library's https://bartlesvillelibrary.com/bookswebsite more/suggest-a-purchase/. You can also view our new items and items on order on our website under the new materials button. Over 3,400 physical books and numerous ebooks have been added in the past year. Users can also make suggestions on Libby by using a "Notify Me" smart tag. Interlibrary Loans are also available for a small fee of \$3.00 to request items from other library collections.

Here is how to make suggestions in the libby app:

In Libby, you can find titles your library doesn't offer and use a "Notify Me" smart tag to express interest in books to your library. Here's a brief summary of how it works:

You'll find titles that aren't offered by your library when:

- You run a search and no titles in your library's collection match your search query.
- You run a search with fewer than 100 results, and you manually turn on the "deep search" filter in the search results screen.
- You can set up a "Notify Me" smart tag for titles not offered by your library. When you tag a title with your "Notify Me" smart tag, your interest in the book is anonymously shared with all of your saved libraries.
- If a title you've tagged with your "Notify Me" smart tag is purchased, you'll get a notification and have the option to borrow it or place it on hold right away.
