Children's Draw with Illustrator Rich Davis. June 13th at 11 AM - Kids come out and learn tips and techniques from Rich Davis on illustrating.



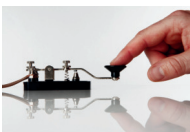
Children's Magic Show with Kevin Wade June 19th at 6 PM - Come and be amazed by the Mystifying Kevin Wade.

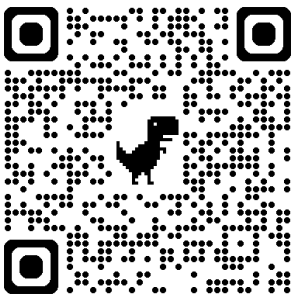

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MEMORIAL DAY SERVICE AT WHITE ROSE CEMETERY



White Rose Cemetery is hosting its annual Memorial Day Service on Monday, May 27th at 9:00 am. The service will include a guest speaker, a memorial wreath presentation, and more. We hope that you join us on this day of remembrance to honor our loved ones.

For Memorial Day, we encourage families to come and place flowers on the graves of their loved ones. Flowers and plants are permitted to be placed on graves for Easter, Mother's Day, Father's Day, Memorial Day, Veterans' Day, and Christmas Day. Winter wreaths or blankets will be removed on March 1st of each year. Cut flowers may be used at any time; however, no wire or glass may be used in floral arrangements. Planting is not permitted on burial spaces.

White Rose Cemetery hosts a few other events throughout the year. This year, Mausoleum Stories will take place on October 19, 2024, with two different show times that evening. Tickets to Mausoleum Stories will be sold at the Bartlesville Public Library closer to the event date. The Luminary Service is set for November 23rd at 6:00 pm. Luminaries will be available to purchase at the Bartlesville Public Library closer to the event date.
