



LIBRARY OF THINGS POLICY

The Bartlesville Public Library offers a collection of non-traditional materials to support the Library's mission of educating and entertaining a diverse audience, stimulating individual learning and advancing society.

Library of Things acquisitions follow the Bartlesville Public Library's Collection Development Policy.

Borrower Guidelines:

A valid library card with photo ID is required to check out an item. The patron must be in good standing, with fines below \$10.00.

Patrons must read and sign the checkout agreement form for every item borrowed.

Patrons under 18 may check out items that are designated as "KIDS" in the Library of Things, but a parent or caregiver must be present and sign off on the agreement form for the item.

Circulation Guidelines:

Library of Things items check out for 14 days. Items may be renewed if not on hold for another patron.

Overdue Things accrue late fines of \$1.00 per day, with a maximum of \$20.

Abuse of Library of Things policy could lead to suspension or loss of borrowing privileges.

The patron is solely responsible for the Thing and may be billed reasonable repair or replacement costs.
