

**BARTLESVILLE PUBLIC LIBRARY**  
**USE OF PUBLIC SPACES ON LIBRARY PROPERTY**

The Bartlesville Public Library seeks to provide space for educational, cultural, charitable, governmental, and civic purposes. Such spaces may not be used for the gain of a specific group or individual. To ensure a non-disruptive environment, solicitation of any kind is not permitted within library buildings or on library property. This includes requesting petition signatures, donations, sales, or approaching patrons for advocacy or promotional purposes. Exceptions may be made for groups whose activities directly profit the library, or whose activities are library-related. Such a decision may be made only by the Library Director or designee and may be subject to re-evaluation by the Board of the Bartlesville Public Library if needed or requested.

The use of library space by any group or organization does not constitute an endorsement of that sponsoring group's policies or beliefs.
